## DEPARTMENTS / POLICIES

### Service Department

Our Service Department, comprised of seven dedicated staff members, is responsible for:

- Snow Removal
- Township Cemetery Maintenance
- Road Maintenance and Repairs
- Culvert Maintenance and Repair
- Park Maintenance

### Planning & Zoning Department

The Batavia Township Planning & Zoning Department enforces the Zoning Resolution. Most new projects will require a permit, including but not limited to:

- Structural Additions
- Pools
- Decks
- Accessory Structures
- Fences

### Transient Vendors

Batavia Township requires a permit for door-to-door vendors. Residents can contact the township to be added to the No Solicitation List.

## Parking Regulations

Batavia Township enforces parking regulations on township streets. These regulations are in addition to any local HOA regulations. PODs/dumpsters, trailers, moving vans, and commercial vehicles are only allowed on streets for loading/unloading.
