LAW ENFORCEMENT MONTHLY REPORT

Deputy Jesse Kidder gave the Batavia Township crime report for the month of March. There were 161 offense reports, a 16% increase from February. The highest crime type report was drug offenses. For the Batavia Township Deputy activity: There were 29 adult arrests and 2 juvenile arrests. There were 44 warrant services and attempts. There were 20 traffic citations and 28 warnings. There were 186 business checks in the Township. They assisted other law enforcement agencies 44 times. There was a total of 481 calls for service in March. We recovered \$700 in stolen property. There were two overdoses. One burglary was reported, and no breaking and entering. The Deputies have been patrolling for speeding in the subdivisions. Pierce Township put up their speeding camera.

SERVICE DIRECTOR REPORT

Steven Tyminski, Assistant Service Director, gave the March Township Service Dept. report. Present tonight also was Ken Embry, Service Director.

We will be getting 100 more tons of sale tomorrow. We have 800 ton in the barn and have used 737 ton this past year. The salt we borrowed from other agencies has all been paid back. There were repairs made on the Vactor truck.

The building was winterized. Playground mulch has been ordered and should be here soon.

Kenny Embry gave an update about working with Steven and mentoring him.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR/INSPECTOR REPORT

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Brad Harris, Zoning Inspector, gave the March permit activity report. There were 12 single family permits and a total of 45 permits this month. There have been 112 permits so far this year.

The Zoning Appeals met once in March and reviewed a single case. On April 26th they will see three cases.

The Zoning Commission will meet on April 15th and will hear two cases that will come to the Trustees in May.

The picnic shelters have really picked up in activity. The baseball fields 2 and 3 look great, field 4 may need work next year. The concession stand help is doing a great job. Signs warning about fly balls will be hung soon.

TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

Adele gave the Amelia update. The next State Auditor working group meeting is April 30th. The next Amelia Council meeting is April 23rd at 3 p.m. The Administrative agreement with the County has been signed for the CDBG grant money. They will be doing an environmental review for the projects.

Concerning the American Rescue Plan Act, the Ohio Townships are not included in funding. There are many unknowns. Mrs. Evans spoke about the CARES Act. We still have funds to spend until the end of the year.

Mrs. Evans gave an update on park projects. The community center is reopened to access the building. Events can be scheduled starting May 1st. There will be a cleaning fee of \$40.00.

Republic trash amnesty dates are May 31st thru June 4th for Batavia Township. They agreed to provide four dumpsters on Saturday, June 5th from 8am-2pm for all residents. There is a 2-load limit for the dumpsters. This will be at the maintenance building. Shred day will be on June 5th from 9am-12pm. It will be at the Township Center. This is for Batavia Township residents only.

Mrs. Evans gave the Trustees a list of previous Salute To Leaders awardees.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Parsons introduced Dave Schultz who helped build the first playground at the Township Center. He is here as a visitor. Mr. Schultz did speak about the tornado sirens. He had not heard them the last few months. Mrs. Evans explained the reason for this. April's siren is scheduled to sound tomorrow, April 7th.
